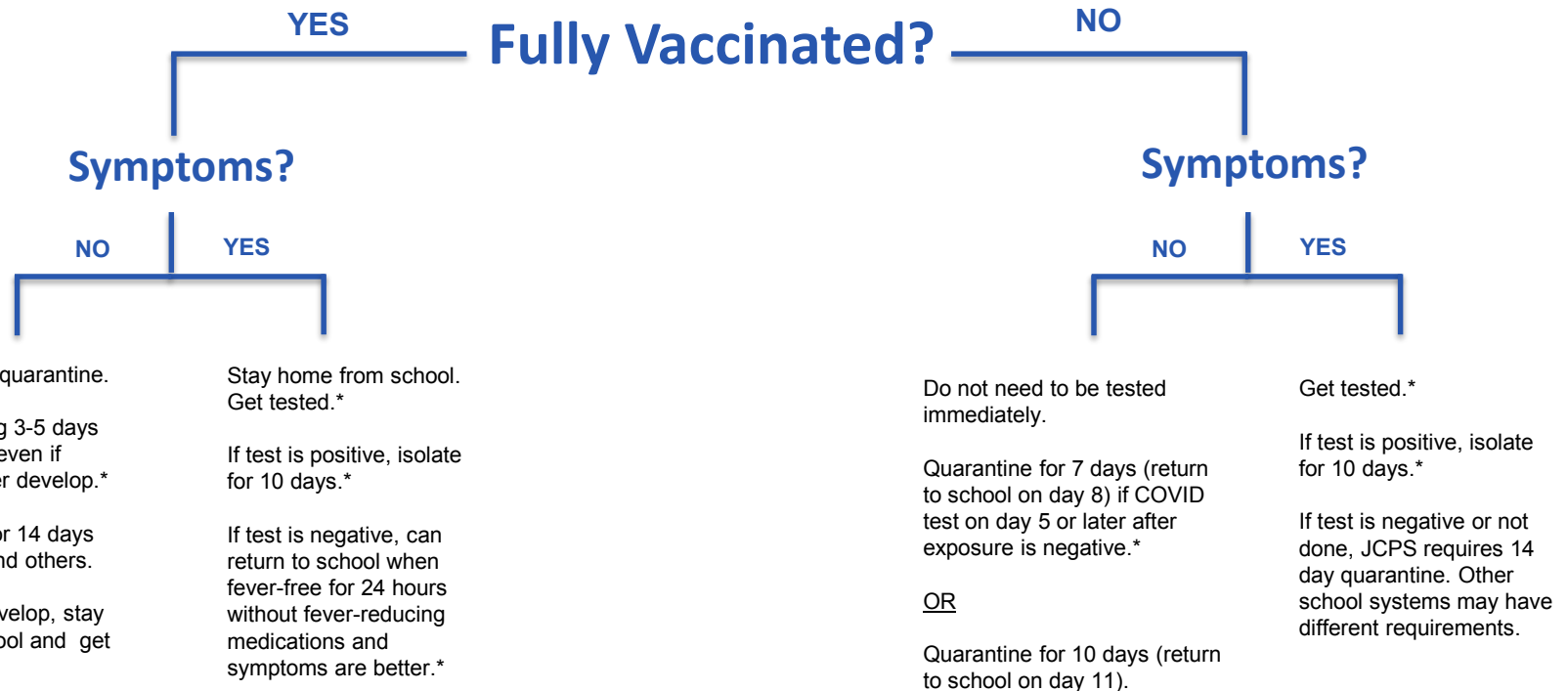


Exposure to COVID-19?

Exposure in most settings defined as being within 6 feet of an infected person for a cumulative total of 15 minutes in 24 hours while the person was considered contagious. A person is contagious for 2 days before symptoms develop or if no symptoms, 2 days before a positive test.

Exposure definitions for children in K-12 school are different:

- If all children are wearing masks, exposure is defined as being within 3 feet of an infected person for a cumulative total of 15 minutes while the person was considered contagious.
- If children are not wearing masks, exposure is defined as being within 6 feet of an infected person for a cumulative total of 15 minutes while the person was considered contagious.



*COVID-19 PCR or antigen test. At home tests should be repeated by a medical professional or school recommended testing site to confirm. Serology (blood tests) not routinely recommended and are not used to make decisions about isolation.
