



Virtual Desktop Includes:

- Microsoft Office Apps
- Microsoft Teams

Disadvantages:

You cannot install any additional applications

Advantages:

- Is <u>not</u> subject to webpage blocking that Norton implements on their network, even when you access it on their network
- You can install browser extensions (like password managers)



What Financial Data/Information Norton Healthcare Can Routinely Provide:

Increasingly Clinical Research Sponsors (especially Industry Sponsors) are requesting financial information related to clinical services provided to research participants/patients. Requests from Research Sponsors to date for financially-related clinical services information include; (1) clinical services "charges" data, (2) actual "negotiated reimbursement rates" for clinical services with different payers and (3) actual patient "out of pocket" costs for clinical services.

To facilitate review/processing, NHC requests that UL researchers contact NHC research as soon as a study is submitted that requests financial data. NHC Research will create a simple form for completion. NHC can provide to Research Sponsors, clinical services charges data(#1 above), in the aggregate, or by procedure, for research participants/patients when addressed in the research informed consent/authorization documentation and is part of (assuming the agreement ONLY proposes clinical services "Charges" data) the NHRO agreement with the sponsor/UofL.




A Few Tips
