 - Wins: the clinical integration provide many lessons; combining two group and that now collaborate was a win with better care, more diversity, and stronger patient experience; another win is the combining of two outpatient follow-up clinics and still keeping two sites; outreach has integrated and continues around the state; these Collaboration are a win
