A Few Alerts...

- If you are planning to submit a grant, remember that OSPA needs a minimum of 5 days to review it prior to submission
 - The budget and any required documents that need to be reviewed or signed off by the Department of Pediatrics need to be submitted to the Chair's office for Dr. Janice Sullivan and Jared Neal to review prior to sign off.
 - It is best to allow at least 3-5 days for this (before the OSPA submission)
- PAS abstracts are due January 4, 2023

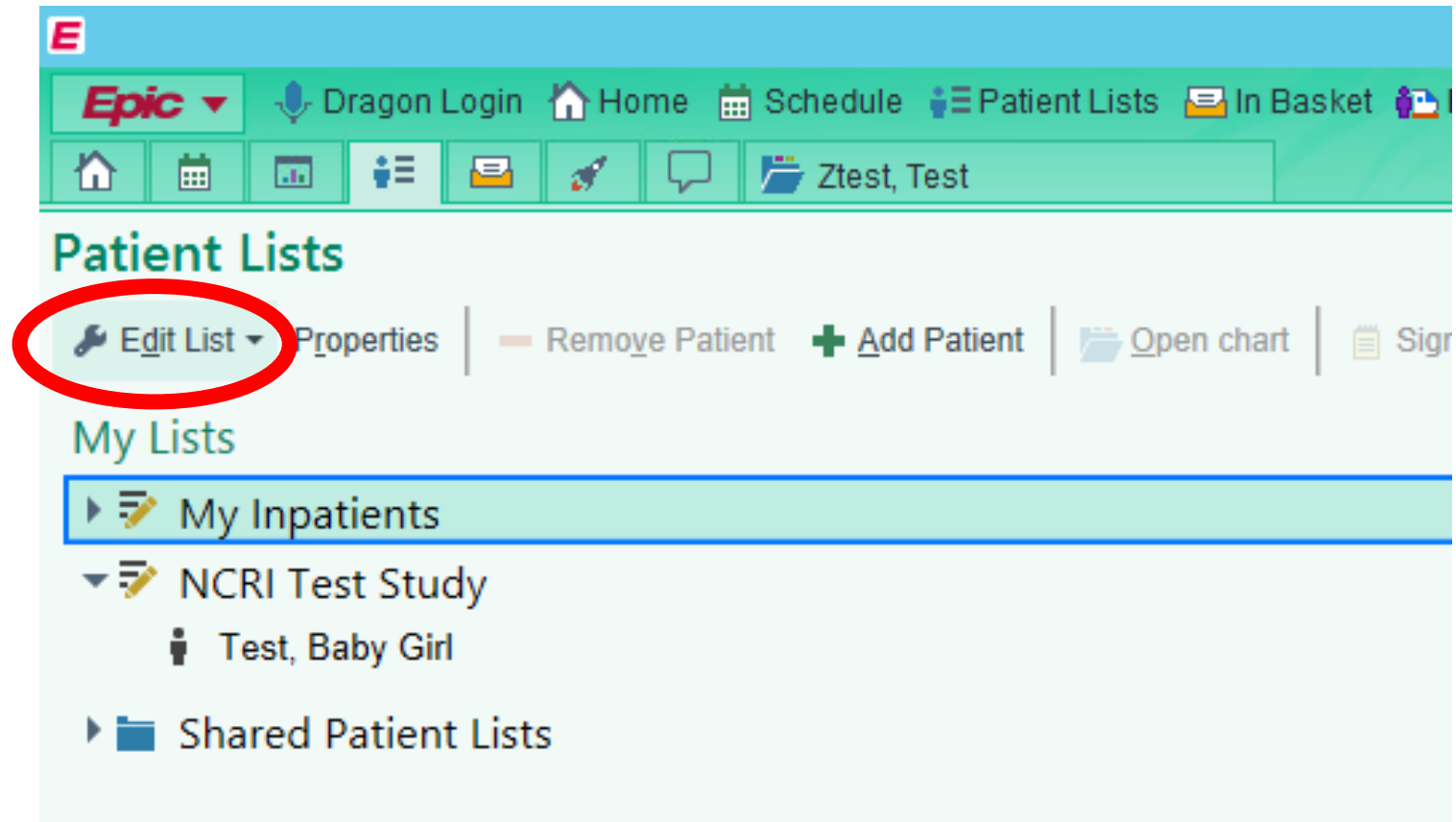
Accessing Charts for Research

Take Home Message:

When you access a chart for a research purpose add the patient to a list with the name:
“NCRI – <<the study’s NHRO number>>”

Step 1: Make a list

Select “Edit List”, and then select “Create My List” from the menu:

Name the list “NCRI - <<the study’s NHRO number>>”, and share it with everyone working on the study (must have IRB approval, of course)

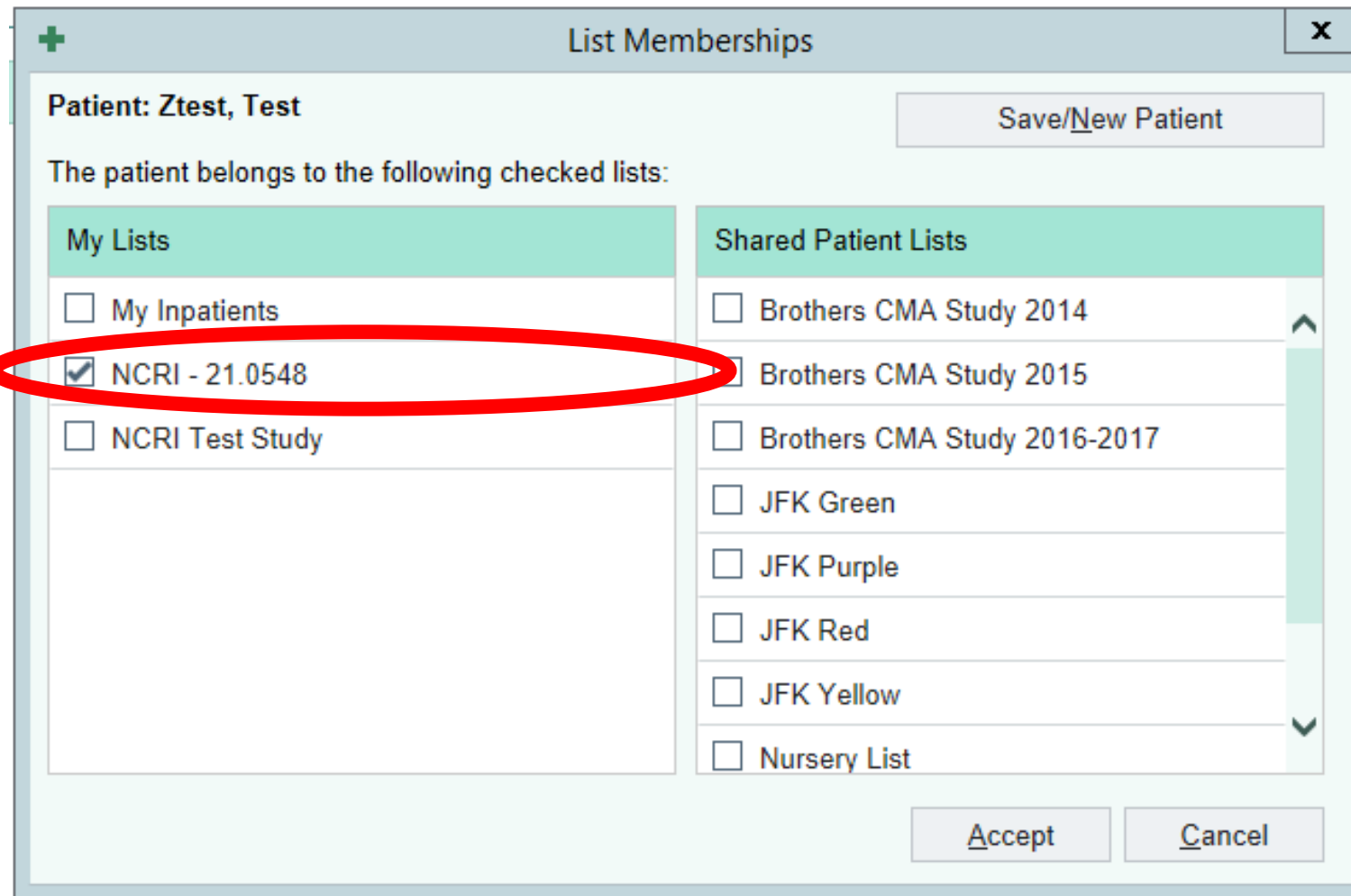
