Travel Cards

- **Submit expense reports with receipts for ALL travel charges**, regardless of payment source within 60 days after returning from travel.
- **Personal meals vs Business meals:**
 - ❑ **Personal meals are not allowed** on *Travel Cards*. They can be reimbursed to you as per diem or from itemized receipts.
 - ❑ **Business meals**, where University business is discussed, **are allowed** on *Travel Cards*. Documentation must include list of attendees and the nature of University business discussed.

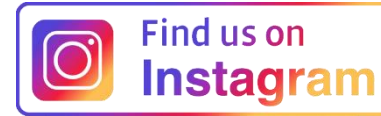
