

A Few Alerts...

- If you are planning to submit a grant, remember that OSPA needs a minimum of 5 days to review it prior to submission
 - The budget and any required documents that need to be reviewed or signed off by the Department of Pediatrics need to be submitted to the Chair's office for Dr. Janice Sullivan and Jared Neal to review prior to sign off.
 - It is best to allow at least 3-5 days for this (before the OSPA submission)
 - There is a change in processes due to incompatibility with NIH system—will provide that once it is finalized

A Few Alerts...

- If you are planning to be a co-investigator on grants led by other departments, please involve NCRI (submit as a request for service)
 - If you are already involved in a grant led by other departments and have not gone through NCRI, please email Dr. Janice Sullivan (sully@louisville.edu) and provide the details.
- NHRO requires all investigators to sign a Data Use Acknowledgment Form for each project—we are working to refine this form/process
- Sponsored accounts—if someone working on a research project with you leaves let us know (also need to remove them from IRB)

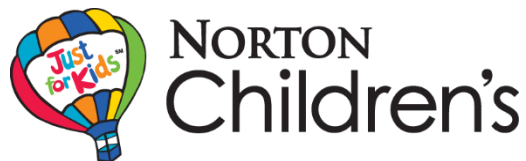
