


Black History Month Film Series





Travel Cards

- Submit expense reports with receipts for ALL travel charges, regardless of payment source within 60 days after returning from travel.
- Personal meals vs Business meals:
 - □ Personal meals are not allowed on Travel Cards. They can be reimbursed to you as per diem or from itemized receipts.
 - Business meals, where University business is discussed, are allowed on Travel Cards. Documentation must include list of attendees and the nature of University business discussed.





