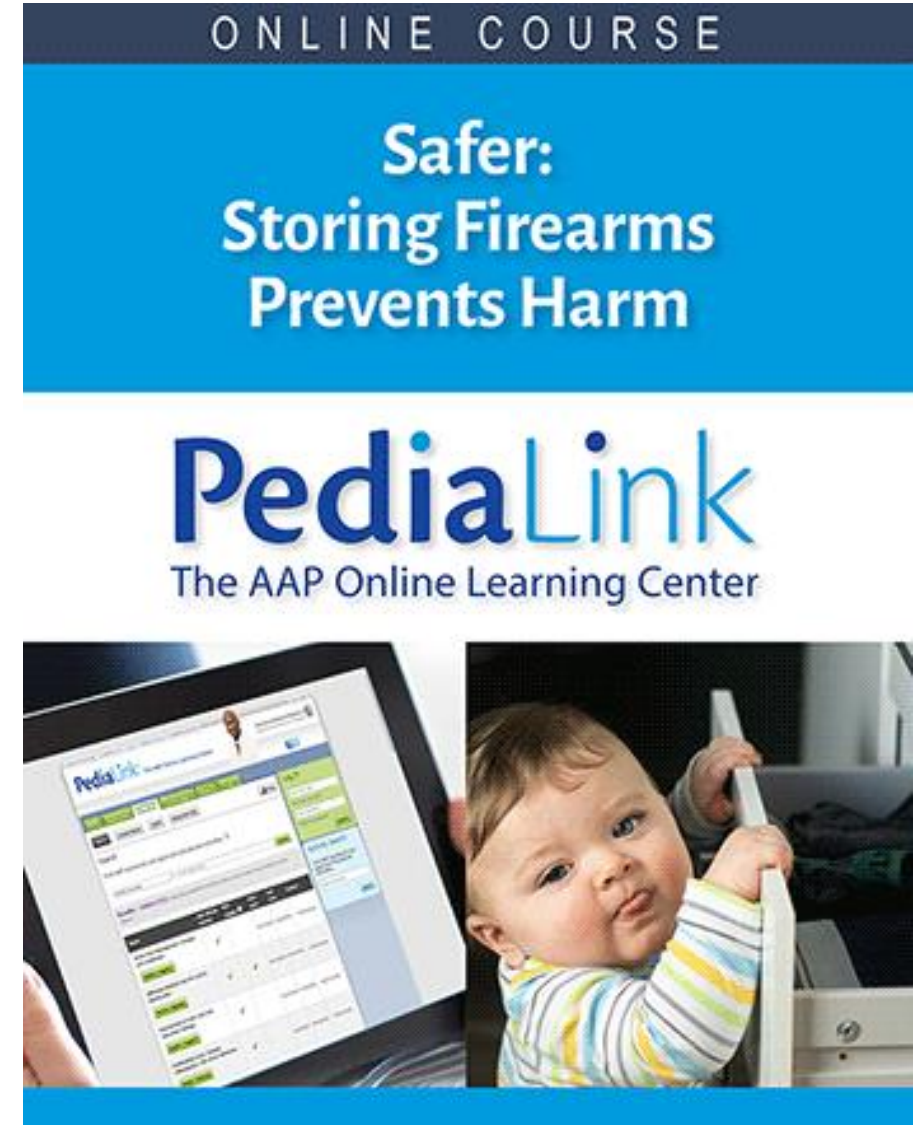


Patient – Level: Injury Prevention

The ordinance unanimously passed and will require landlords to remove lead-based hazards from rental properties.
