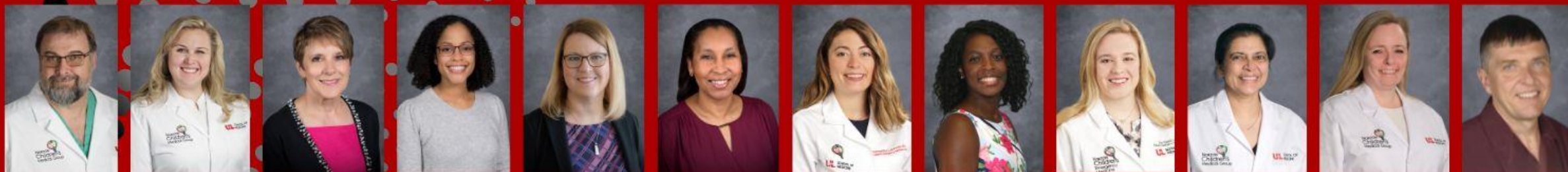

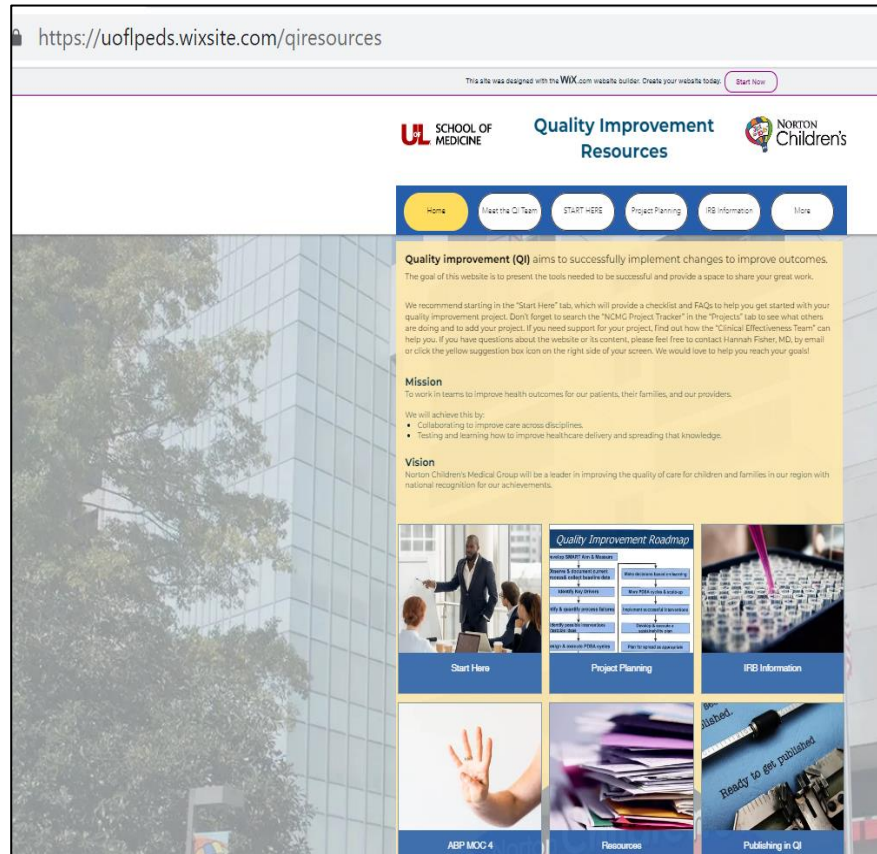

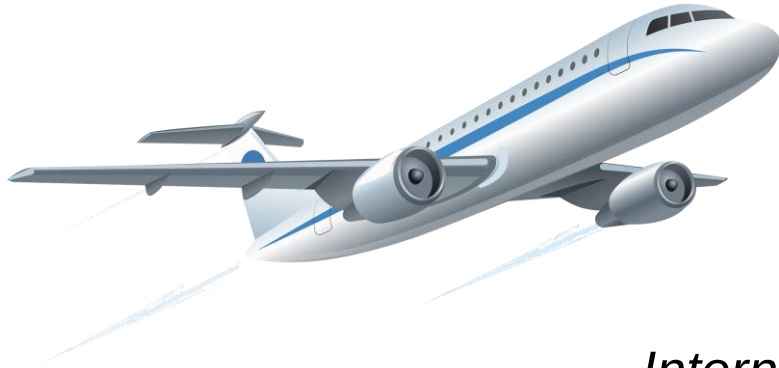

 - ❑ **Personal meals** are not allowed on *Travel Cards*. They can be reimbursed to you as per diem or from itemized receipts.
 - ❑ **Business meals**, where University business is discussed, **are allowed** on *Travel Cards*. Documentation must include list of attendees and the nature of University business discussed.
