

2019 Undergraduate Student Application University of Louisville Cancer Education Program (CEP)

The 2019 CEP program for undergraduate students will begin Tuesday after Memorial Day (Tuesday, May 28th) and will continue full time for 10 weeks (ending Friday, August 2nd). **The position requires your full-time effort and commitment.** Students accepted into the CEP program will not be able to participate in another activity (e.g., enrollment in classes, pre-matriculation program, other summer employment, international internship, etc.) during the ten weeks of the program. Students may be permitted up to one week of vacation during the program provided it is approved by the program administration and faculty mentor.

Student subsistence allowance is provided up to \$4000 for undergraduate students. Additional funds can be provided to non-local participants to defray housing and travel expenses to and from Louisville. The program has arranged with university-affiliated housing for students outside of the Louisville Metropolitan area, or students may arrange their own housing.
