UofL Celebrates 200 Years

Dr. Leonard J. Weiner was the first Chief of Plastic Surgery at the University of Louisville, appointed in 1971 and continued in that position until 1996. In those 25 years, he would establish a plastic surgery legacy at the University of Louisville that will proudly stand the test of time.

Under Dr. Weiner's leadership, the UofL plastic surgery program achieved many advances and was trend-setting. These advances included the first microsurgical teaching lab, the first microsurgical fellowship, surgical anatomy lab, early tangential excision and grafting, making skin grafts with culture, myocutaneous and muscle flaps, and ultimately contributing to the composite tissue allotransplantation.

He built a strong plastic surgery research program that contributed to hundreds of peer-reviewed publications to the field of plastic surgery. He strategically recruited strong faculty to develop and direct a first-rate plastic surgery residency program at the University of Louisville.

Even in his retirement, Dr. Weiner continued to bestow his enthusiasm and knowledge of plastic surgery with his continued participation in journal clubs and visiting professor events. Together, Dr. Weiner and his wife Dr. Jane Schultz established the Leonard J. Weiner, MD Professorship of Plastic Surgery at the University of Louisville, which continues to promote plastic surgery excellence and support to the community and institution forever.

Dr. Weiner was a loving father, grandfather, brother, husband, and friend. He was a renaissance man with many interests and hobbies. He taught and mentored enthusiastically. He took his "bigger than life" charisma everywhere – to the game, the track, to France, and to his practice, and teaching. Dr. Weiner has left an indelible mark on us all, and his legacy of love, his zest for knowledge, and his compassion for the human spirit will continue to inspire us.

The Weiner family requests gifts in honor of Dr. Weiner to be made to the Leonard J. Weiner Endowed Fund in Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery at the University of Louisville. This endowed professorship supports the educational and research activities in the Division of Plastic Surgery.
