

Health Equity and Medical Justice Track (DIHEMJ)

Application to the DIHEMJ track requires:

- CV (see link to template on main application page). You will upload your CV when prompted. Submit your CV as a pdf and use the following format for the filename: Lastname_Firstname_CV.
- Statement of Experience with Health Equity and Social Justice: Describe any
 experience you have had with health equity and social justice movements, or
 any other related work. You will paste this into a text box within the
 application.
- Short Essay: Based on your interests, write a 1-2 page statement responding to <u>one</u> of these two questions:
- 1. Reflect on how institutional power and privilege factor into the health disparities we see in Jefferson County, KY?
- 2. Conceptions of justice consist of the following dimensions: distributive justice, relational justice and procedural justice. Reflect on how each of these dimensions is relevant to health equity.

Use 12 point Arial font and 1-inch margins Submit your Essay as a pdf and use the following format for the filename: Lastname_Firstname_Essay.

After you've prepared these materials, access the DIHEMJ application portal from the main application page. Complete the demographic information and Statement of Experience, and upload your CV and Short Essay when prompted.
