Education

- **Undergraduate/Medical Student Education**
 - Coordination of the *Introduction to Clinical Medicine*, two year course in first two years of medical school
 - 3rd year medical students – 6 week Family Medicine Clerkship
 - 4 week AHEC rotation - placing medical students in rural or underserved areas of Kentucky
 - Service learning component
 - 2 week rotation in DFGM offices
 - 4th year medical students
 - Clinical rotations in sports medicine, nutrition, geriatrics, acting internship, medical Spanish, school health, medical informatics, longitudinal ambulatory rotations, clinical elective rotations in Louisville, throughout Kentucky, other states in the US, and rotations outside the USA.
 - Offer rotations for students from other Medical schools
 - Average around 100, 4th year rotations
 - Approximately 11 % Family medicine match rate. This year 16 out of 140 graduating medical students matched in Family Medicine

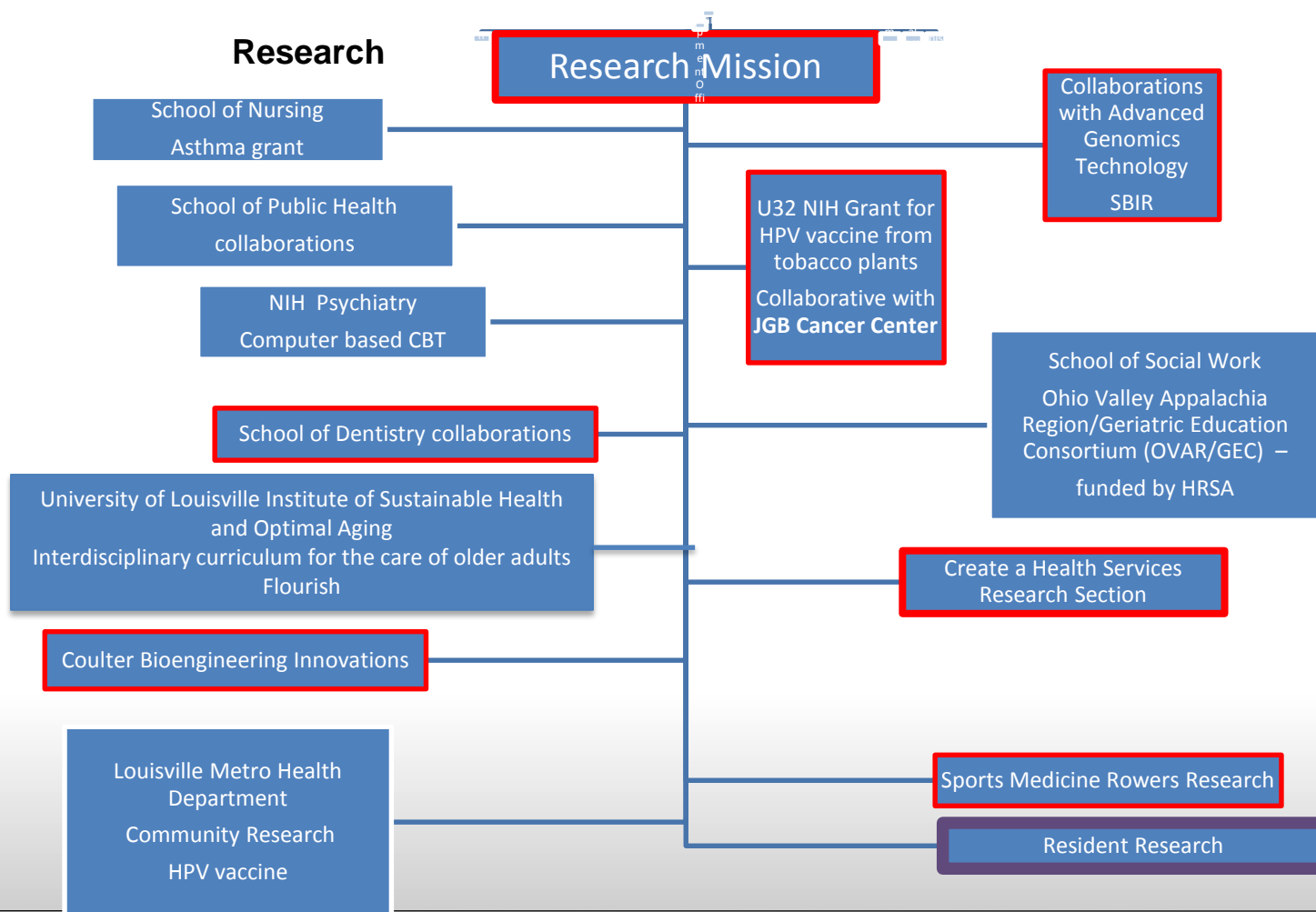
