




Mission, Goal, Objective, Strategy, and Tactics

- Mission your North star. Fixed point to navigate by.
- •Goal- your destination. Must be defined enough to know when you've gotten there.
- •Objectives- milestones along the way
- Strategy- your plan to achieve your goal
- Tactics methods used to implement strategy






Your Values

Workplace Values


Independence/ Adventure/risk-taking- activities with high risk/reward
Ethical standards
Expertise/Competence
Utilize Skills- making the most of the skills you have at your job
Creativity/Problem-solving
Precision work- requires extreme attention to detail, with little margin for error
Intellectual challenge- requires constant learning and thought to be effective
Social contribution- work that focuses on improving society
Personal fulfillment- work that gives a sense of personal satisfaction, with or without external recognition or reward


Your Skills


