

My LEAPS is the new service activity portfolio that manages all medical student service related learning experiences, hours served, critical reflections and feedback. There are two components to the portfolio:

My Service Learning and My Community Service

What is Service Learning? Service learning activity is a structured learning experience that combines community service with preparation and reflection. It provides a student an opportunity to actively participate and directly learn in a structured environment while challenging personal assumptions, beliefs, and thought patterns. It has objectives and contains a reflection as well as a feedback component about **learning experiences** performed either in a local or an international setting.

Service Learning is considered to be one of the following: Global Health Activities, Third Year Family Medicine AHEC Rotations, Student Free Clinics, and Missions both locally and globally.




