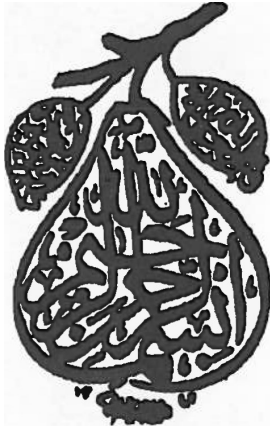


University of Louisville Minor In Middle East And Islamic Studies
