Dr. Marc Hurlbert joined BCRF as Chief Mission Officer in 2015 and oversees BCRF's \$60-million annual grants program focused on research to prevent, treat and cure breast cancer. Marc works closely with BCRF's world-renowned Scientific Advisory Board to execute their vision and strategy for advancing cancer research. With a PhD in pharmacology and two decades of nonprofit

Dr. Hurlbert also serves as chairman of the *Metastatic Breast Cancer Alliance* (http://www.mbcalliance.org) which consists of forty nonprofit organizations, including BCRF, ten pharmaceutical companies and dozens of patients working together to improve the quality and length of life for patients living with metastatic disease.
