Kevin Patrick, MD, MS is Professor of Family Medicine and Public Health at the University of California, San Diego and Director of the Center for Wireless and Population Health Systems at the Qualcomm Institute/Calit2. He is Director of the Health Data Exploration project of the Robert Wood Johnson Foundation (RWJF). He served as Editor-in-Chief of the American Journal of Preventive Medicine from 1994-2013, and has served on the Secretary's Council for Health Promotion and Disease Prevention of the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) and the Armed Forces Epidemiology Board. His research focuses on the use of wearable technologies, text messaging, smartphone apps, mobile video, the mobile web and social media to measure health states and promote health behavior change. Additional present research includes the development of IT systems that support the collection of sensor data from patients in the context of cancer treatment comparative effectiveness research and comprehensive “cells to society” approaches to managing population-level health data to derive new insights into the determinants of health.
