



GRADUATE AWARDS

The University of Louisville School of Music is proud to offer two Master's degrees, a MASTER of MUSIC EDUCATION and a MASTER of MUSIC with 15 concentrations: Conducting (Choral, Orchestral, Wind), Electronic Music Composition, Instrumental Music Performance, Jazz Composition & Arranging, Jazz Performance, Music Composition, Music History & Literature, Music Theory, Piano Pedagogy, Piano Performance, String Pedagogy, Vocal Performance, and Wind Band Pedagogy.



Graduate Teaching Assistantships and Service Awards are open for all areas of the graduate program and based on a competitive application process. Assistantships may include full tuition remission, health care benefits, and up to a \$12,000 stipend for weekly work between 10 and 20 hours. Service awards may include partial tuition remission and weekly assignments of 3 to 10 hours.

Graduate students in performance/pedagogy must complete an audition for entrance to the School of Music. It strongly recommended that all materials be submitted prior to your scheduled audition OR by January 15 for Theory, Composition or History applicants.
