Application deadline, including pre-selection video, August 1st, 2024

Notification of acceptance will be made by September 1st, 2024.

Repertoire

A pre-selection video of 10-15 minutes demonstrating the candidates abilities. Repertoire does not have to be the same as the live round repertoire.

Live round repertoire:

10-15 minutes of music from at least two different styles, including:

Baroque

Classical

Romantic

20th and 21st Century

*Prepared piano works and unpublished pieces are NOT allowed

With the exception of the 20th / 21st Century pieces all works must be memorized
