Hiroko Driver Lippman a graduate of the Suzuki Talent Education Institute in Matsumoto, Hiroko was trained by Dr.Suzuki and William Starr. After coming to US, she taught at the University of Tennessee and later, at the University of Louisville, both as a director and teacher-trainer. She also studied at the Indiana University with Mimi Zweig and Brenda Brunner. Currently, she is the director of her own studio, Suzuki School of Louisville, and is also a concert mistress of the Kling Orchestra.

Dr. Timothy Durbin with his infectious enthusiasm and inspired musicianship, he brings smiles and laughter to students throughout the United States and around the world. His dynamic teaching career includes over 800 workshops and institutes! Dr. Durbin holds a DMA in orchestral conducting from Claremont Graduate University in Los Angeles, California, a Masters in violin performance from the University of Illinois, an undergraduate degree in violin performance from the University of Alabama, and is currently the director of the Suzuki String Program at the University of Louisville.

Susannah Onwood "former Principal Cellist of the Louisville Orchestra", has taught students of all ages at U of L for many years and now in her private studio. Ms. Onwood has a Bachelor of Music with Distinction and Performer's Certificate from Eastman School of Music and a Master of Music from IU at Bloomington. She founded the Kentucky Cello Club and served as President for many years. In 2000 she was awarded "Outstanding Teacher of the Year" by KY ASTA with NSOA. Ms. Onwood attended the Chicago Suzuki Institute and has also taught at the IUS Summer String Clinic.

Michael Hill holds degrees from the University of Cincinnati's College Conservatory of Music and the University of Louisville where he teaches violin, viola and chamber music. Mr Hill also teaches through Indiana University southeast and has been a guest for masterclasses and young artist competitions throughout the region. He also performs in regional chamber ensembles and orchestras and is currently pursuing a Master of Music in String Pedagogy at the University of Louisville.

Dr. Robert Amchin a distinguished teaching professor of music education at the University of Louisville enjoys leading undergraduate and graduate classes in teacher education to music education majors. Dr. Amchin's training includes studies at the Orff Institute (Salzburg), New England Conservatory of Music, Memphis State University, Hofstra University, Hamline University, and the University of Michigan. He was an elementary music specialist in Spring, Texas and still works with children in the Kentucky area as an artist-in-residence guest music teacher.
