

# 2022 SUMMER MUSIC GRANT

## APPLICATION GUIDELINES

### **DEADLINE - Friday, February 11 at 5:00 pm - no exceptions**

1. **ELIGIBILITY:** You must have been registered as an undergraduate or graduate Music major in Fall 2021 or Spring 2022. MAT students are eligible. Music Therapy equivalency students are not eligible because they are not registered as Music Majors and do not pay the music student fee.
2. Awardees may only qualify for one grant per summer. If you apply for more than one program, the selection committee reserves the option of recommending a specific project for funding. Previous award recipients may apply.
3. Awards typically range from \$100 to \$1,200. For the 2022 program, awards will be capped at \$1200.
4. Applications must be typed onto the Word document provided; handwritten applications will not be accepted.
5. Description of the project and value to your education in music is very important. This is a very competitive grant program in which great ideas, poorly presented, may not be successful.
6. Clarity of presentation is important. Our previous history of reviews suggests that incomplete applications are not given serious consideration.
7. On a separate page, prepare and submit an estimated, yet realistic, budget that includes registration fees, round-trip travel costs, room and board (if applicable), and other anticipated expenses. Your budget should also list all anticipated funding sources, including personal resources.
8. Provide at least one letter of recommendation from a UofL music faculty member of your choice indicating how the proposed activity would benefit you and your program of study. This recommendation may be submitted by letter or email format. Be sure to request this letter at least ten working days before the February 11 deadline. Faculty recommendations may be submitted with the application or emailed directly to Dr. Krista Wallace-Boaz.
9. Provide a brochure or link to the desired program that includes costs and payment due dates.
10. Grant award letters will be e-mailed to successful applicants around March 15<sup>th</sup>. Notice will also be provided to applicants whose proposal will not be funded.
