

# Application Procedures

## Application Procedures for the Bachelor of Science in Nursing Program (BSN)

Students must apply to the University of Louisville as an undergraduate student – Nursing major, to be admitted into the lower division. To be eligible to apply for upper division the student must be in the lower division of Nursing. Students admitted to Arts and Sciences as Pre-Nursing majors are not eligible to apply to upper division and cannot take Pathophysiology or Pharmacology, which are requirements for lower division. To be admitted in Good Standing to the School of Nursing there is a minimum GPA requirement of 2.8 and a minimum composite ACT score of 21.

### Undergraduate Admission Deadlines:

#### Traditional Freshman Priority Deadlines

- Fall Term – February 15
- Spring Term – November 1
- Summer Term - March 1

#### Transfer Priority Deadlines

- Fall Term - July 1
- Spring Term - December 1
- Summer Term - April 1

#### International Applicant Deadlines

- Fall Term - May 1
- Spring Term - November 1
- Summer Term - April 1
