WIRELESS LOCATIONS

The University is installing wireless networking as part of a larger project to upgrade the campus data networking infrastructure. The network upgrades to the Health Sciences campus is complete, and work is beginning on the Belknap and Shelby campus networks. The focus of this initial phase of wireless networking is scheduled classrooms and public areas.

It is important to note that wireless connections are subject to variations in reception influenced by several factors:

- bandwidth can vary with the distance from an access point,
- different brands of wireless card have different transmission and reception characteristics,
- reception can be affected by structural elements within a building (leading to spots where service is not available), and
- radio frequency devices in an area (such as 2.4 GHz cordless telephones, unauthorized wireless access points, or scientific equipment) can generate interference that intermittently affects reception.

The following building locations have working wireless networks installed. Some areas inside these buildings may have weak signal strength that will limit network throughput or access.
