- delivery of library resources not available immediately online, including:
 - retrieval and copying of items from U of L library collections (or from elsewhere, if necessary)
 - mailing, faxing or emailing of requested items to distance learners and professors
 - Costs: Items that cost under \$25.00 per item are delivered at no cost to the individual. Any costs above \$25.00 per item are billed to the individual following pre-approval.
