- Total enrollment: 22,459 (Fall 2017)
- 75% of students attended full-time (Fall 2017)
- Just over 50% of the student body was female (Fall 2017)
- 34% of students came from out of state (Fall 2017)
- Just over 17% of out-of-state students received in-state tuition due to the Indiana Reciprocity agreement (Fall 2017)
- The average ACT score of first-time, full-time, bachelor degree seeking students was 25.4 (Fall 2017)
- The six-year graduation rate for the 2011 cohort was 54.4%
- The freshman-to-sophomore year retention rate for the fall 2016 cohort was 80.6%
- 58% of degrees awarded in 2016-17 were at the bachelor's level
- UofL researchers secured over \$147.8M in external funding for grants and contracts in FY17
