
Materials: 1 board + 1 set of words per 2 students (total: 12 of each)

Momentum: the product of mass and velocity of an objet	Stopping distance: the sum of the thinking distance and the braking distance.
Applied force: a (surface or body) force acting on an object	Instantaneous: happening very quickly (= in an instant)
Air bag: a bag that fills with air to protect a driver or passenger when a vehicle crashes	Hypothesis: an educated guess based on evidence is called a hypothesis.
Relate: to show or make a connection between (two or more things)	Interval: a period of time between events
Effective: having an intended effect	Impulse: the product of the force applied and the time the force is applied; needed to stop an object

Jeopardy

- a. Round 1: "Jeopardy" (Materials: the Wednesday set for the host)
 - i. The class splits into two teams + 1 person is the game host
 - ii. 1 person from each team stands approaches the host's table.
 - iii. The host reads a word, the first person who "pushes a button" gets to provide the word definition. The correct definition gets the team a point.
