David Dollar is a senior fellow in the China Center at the Brookings Institution. He is a leading expert on Asian economies and U.S. relations with Asia. From 2009 to 2013 he was the U.S. Treasury's economic and financial emissary to China, based in Beijing. Before his time in the U.S. Treasury, Dollar worked at the World Bank for 20 years. He was the country economist for Vietnam during 1989-1995, a period of intense reform and adjustment.
