

Paul J. Weber Scholarship *for* Mentoring Excellence



The Paul J. Weber Scholarship for Mentoring Excellence is a tribute to the legacy left by a man who dedicated his life to teaching and mentoring. Just before Dr. Weber's death in 2005, students, colleagues, and friends created an endowment in his honor to fund an annual scholarship at the University of Louisville. This scholarship intends to continue Dr. Weber's legacy by recognizing students who exemplify characteristics of mentoring excellence.

The 2023 award is ***\$5,000.00** (**minimum*)

Deadline to Apply: **February 17th by 5:00 PM**

ELIGIBILITY

- Must be a senior graduating in May 2023, or have graduated prior to May 2023 and returning for graduate school
- Must be a Political Science major or McConnell Scholar
- Must be in good standing with the university
- Must plan to attend graduate or professional school at the University of Louisville in the Fall of 2023 and pursue a degree in one of the following areas:
Music, Political Science, Education, Religion, Psychology, Public Administration, or Law School

A COMPLETE APPLICATION WILL INCLUDE:

- Cover Letter, to provide the following:
Name, student ID, contact information, major, anticipated graduation date, and graduate school plans (including if you have already been accepted to graduate school and your expected start date).
- Applicant Resume
1 page resume detailing college experiences at the University of Louisville
- Essay
In two pages or less, describe the most influential mentor in your personal life and the characteristics of this person that you try to emulate in your own mentoring and/or leadership experiences. Include what you have accomplished as a leader and mentor.
- Unofficial Transcript
