I. Call to Order

II. Report of the Faculty Athletics Representative

Chair Gonzalez explained that FAR Wallace-Boaz was attending the ACC Student Athlete Advisory Committee meeting but had forwarded her written report in advance.

There were no questions from board members.

The chair acknowledged Prof. Wallace-Boaz's tremendous work as the university's Faculty Athletics Representative.

III. Report of the Athletic Director

Athletic Director Heird began his report by asking Associate AD Spoelker to provide a financial update.

Using the **attached** documentation, Mr. Spoelker discussed with directors the revenue and expenditure summaries, sources and uses of operating funds, and the changes of net position of the Athletics department's finances.

He then fielded questions from the board.

AD Heird thanked Mr. Spoelker for his update.

Mr. Heird then continued his report, updating the board about the state of affairs in the Athletics Department, using the **attached** presentation. Highlights included

- Department goals;
- Academic successes in the Fall semester;
- Current fundraising initiatives;
- Football season ticket sales data; and
- Competitive successes and team rankings.

The AD then fielded questions from board members.

Chair Gonzalez thanked AD Heird for his report.

IV. Report of the Chair

Chair Gonzalez began her report with university highlights:

- At the December Commencement Ceremony, 2,239 students earned degrees, with more than 900 walking across the stage.
- Last month, UofL was awarded up to \$13 million from the U.S. Department of Commerce to launch a new statewide manufacturing resource center to help small-and medium-sized businesses accelerate and strengthen growth and competitiveness

in the global marketplace. This grant also makes UofL part of the Manufacturing Extension Partnership National Network, a program meant to strengthen and empower U.S. manufacturers. The network is composed of 51 MEP Centers located in all fifty states and Puerto Rico. The Kentucky Manufacturing Extension Partnership is expected to generate between \$150 million and \$200 million in annual economic growth across our state. This will further enhance Kentucky's stellar reputation in the manufacturing sector.

- The Trager family donated \$1 million to the university to aid in the creation of an urban micro-forest at Founders Square Park in downtown Louisville, adjacent to the Envirome Institute's New Vision of Health Campus.
- Retired U.S. Rep. John Yarmuth donated his congressional papers to UofL Archives and Special Collections; a wonderful resource for our students and the community.
- The university announced the Grawemeyer Awards in December. Several of the awards received national media attention.
- UofL Health has partnered with Central High School on a pre-medical magnet program.
- Work is ongoing on a \$144 million expansion of University of Louisville Hospital.
- Raise Some L raised nearly \$3.3 million.
- President Kim Schatzel begins her new tenure on February 1.

Dr. Gonzalez concluded her report by stating that it has been a joy to serve the university as interim president and as Chair of the ULAA board, and that she looks forward to keeping UofL moving forward as provost.

The Board of Directors gave the Chair a round of applause.

V. Executive Session

Mr. Gill made a motion, which Ms. Zimmerman seconded, to recess to executive session to discuss a specific business proposal, pursuant to KRS 61.810(1)(g).

The motion passed and the open meeting recessed at 9:55 a.m.

VI. Open Meeting Reconvenes

FY23 YTD Highlights

Revenues

- 55% of budgeted operating revenues have been realized through December, compared to 61% in prior year. (\$9M decrease from the prior year)
 - \$6.5M is due to Chic-Fil-A game and one extra home football game in the prior year.
 - \$2M is related to decrease in MBB ticket sales, suites and seat donations

Expenses

- 47% of budgeted operating expenses have been spent through December.
- Overall, operating expenses tracking to budget. Men's Basketball will exceed original budget due to increased travel and recruiting costs.
- · Salaries, student meals and recruiting expenses slightly higher from last year
- Staff will continue to manage expenses despite increased costs of goods and services

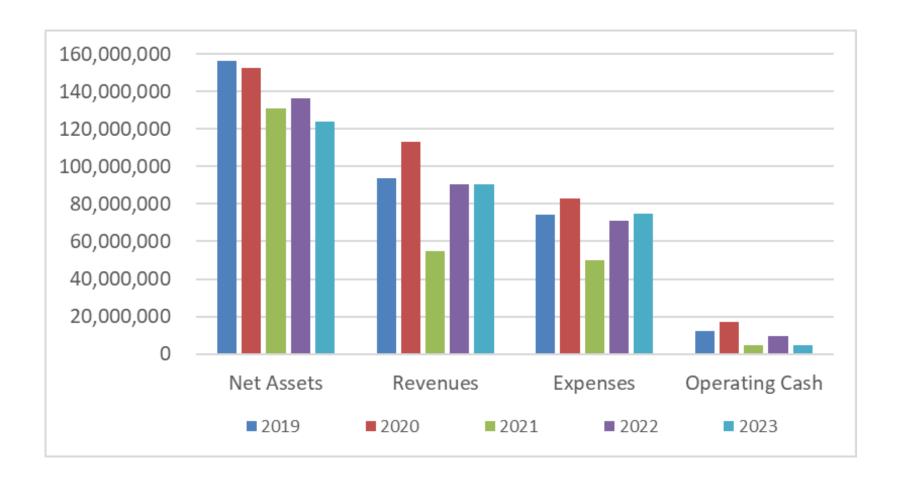

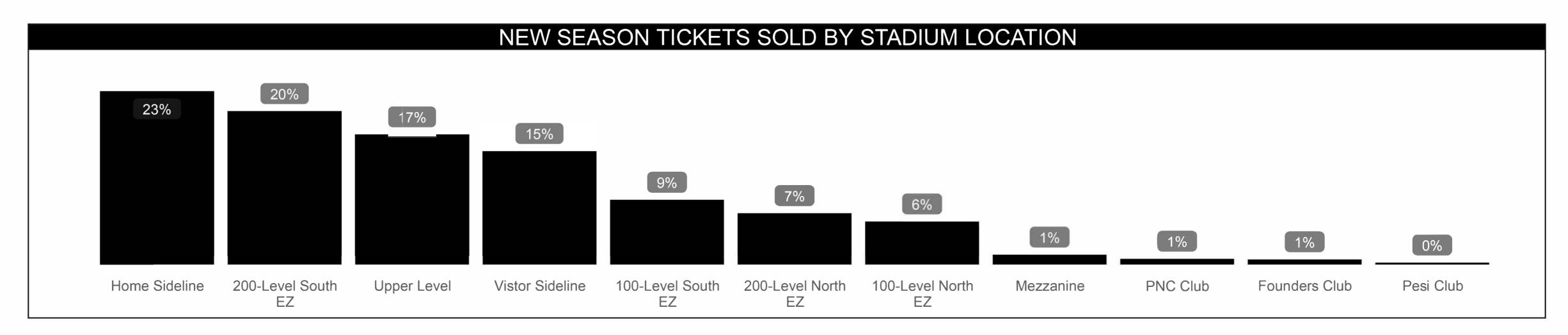

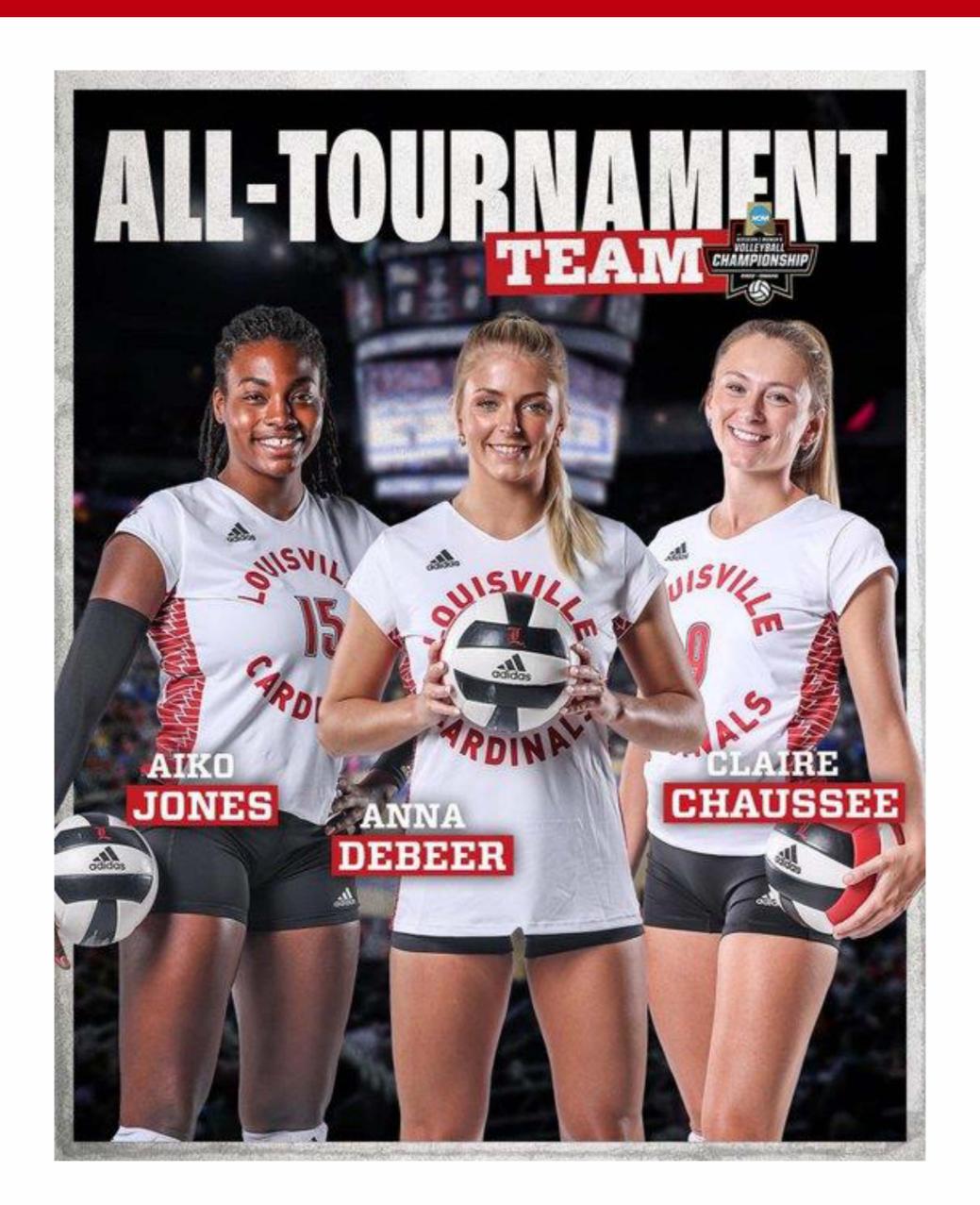

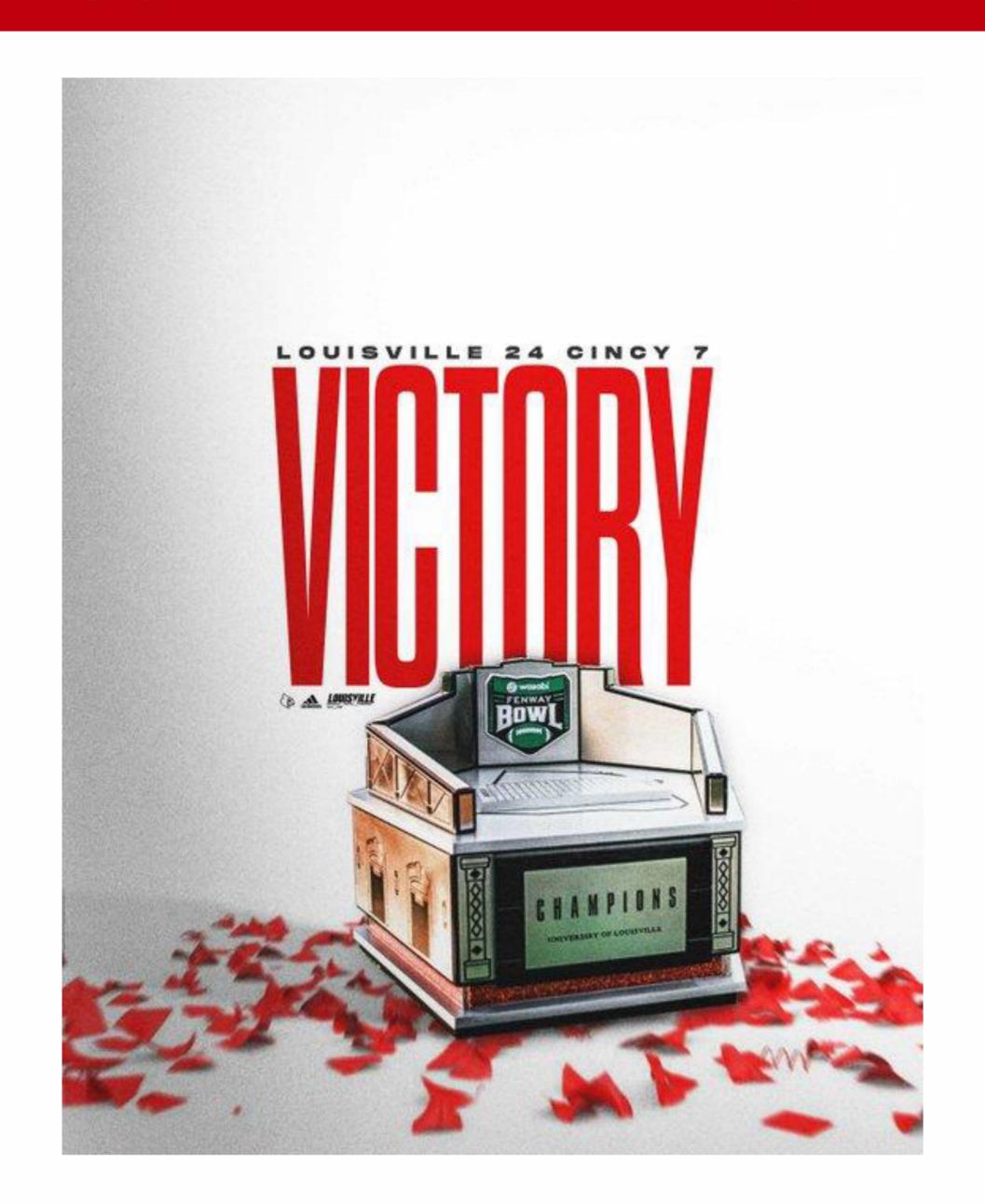
