# Review and Approval of November 11, 2022, Meeting Minutes:

The minutes from November 11, 2022, meeting were reviewed and approved. **ACTION:** Samuelsen will post the minutes to the Cardinal Core website.

## **Subcommittee Updates:**

#### **Diversity Petition Subcommittee:**

Shanahan provided an update. They approved a resubmitted military petition. The student properly addressed all the subcommittee's comments from the first review. The subcommittee also reviewed a Cardinal Core course proposal for D1, SW 207: Historical Contemp. Abolition (SB, D1). The subcommittee recommended to the committee of a whole that the course be approved with minor modifications (assessments need more details and connection to the assignments), which was approved (see Course Proposal Subcommittee portion for more details).

#### **Assessment Subcommittee:**

Shanahan provided an update. They are collecting artifacts for the Arts and Humanities (AH) and Quantitative Reasoning (QR) assessments. Shanahan has already inventoried 175 QR artifacts. In addition, the subcommittee is reviewing a draft summary of the first cycle of assessments to set targets/goals to focus on for the next cycle of assessments.

#### **Course Proposal Subcommittee:**

Wright provided an update. The Course Proposal Subcommittee reviewed 2 new Cardinal Core course proposals. The two courses were sent to the Cardinal Core Curriculum Committee prior to this meeting to vote on their approval of the Course Proposal and Diversity Subcommittees recommendations. The Course Proposal Subcommittee recommended the approval of PHIL 308: Freedom, Equality, Justice & Com. (SB). The committee of the whole approved the subcommittee's



recommendation with 19 votes (out of 20) in favor. The Course Proposal Subcommittee and the Diversity Subcommittee recommended SW 207: Historical Contemp. Abolition (SB, D1) be approved with minor modifications. 16 votes (out of 20) were in favor and 3 requested further discussion during our meeting today. After further discussion, the subcommittees recommendation for SW 207: Historical Contemp. Abolition (SB, D1) was approved by the committee of the whole.

#### **Digital Competency Subcommittee:**

Hagan provided an update. Hagan met with Jason Zahrndt from the Digital Media Suite, and they are interested in a Cardinal Core designated partnership with Cards Create. The subcommittee is going to try to identify Cardinal Core instructors/courses that have good digital competency and encourage them to have their students submit for the showcase/prizes. The key to the Cards Create is that students have to submit, but faculty can encourage submissions. The subcommittee is going to meet again on January 13 to discuss further and compile a short list of faculty/courses to target. They can review the Cards Create archives for past submissions and mine the faculty from Adobe Day of Discovery. The subcommittee is also discussing having informative sessions with Delphi, like during the Adobe Day of Discovery.
