Position Summary

- Work closely with QEP director, campus leaders and partners to develop the QEP goals, outcomes, implementation plans and assessment protocol in line with SACSCOC expectations and best practices of action research and assessment principles.
- Provide strategic support in the identification, organization, interpretation, and sharing of meaningful institutional data sources to inform the QEP development process
- Produce memos, reports, presentations, graphics, and visualizations as part of the development of the QEP evaluation and assessment plan
- Attend meetings of the QEP Development Committee and assist the director of the QEP in planning and managing committee tasks related to assessment.
- Collaborate with staff in institutional effectiveness and institutional research as part of the QEP development process
- Demonstrate proficiency in applied research design and implementation principles as relevant to the future QEP.
- Provide agile and insightful leadership in finalizing and refining the QEP assessment protocol through the ongoing QEP research and stakeholder input process.
- Work with the QEP director to identify and consult with relevant campus partners and experts to inform the assessment plan. Offer strategic ongoing support to the QEP Proposal drafting, development and finalization\ process.
