Leadership

Leadership is the desire and ability to inspire others and the willingness to help them succeed. Leaders must recognize, respect, and encourage the unique strengths of others to enable a group to achieve a shared vision.

Write about an experience that shows your leadership or your preparation to be a leader.

Community Engagement

Community engagement implies your involvement and participation in an organization for the good of the community. A community-engaged scholar or student recognizes and acts on their responsibilities to their communities, local, national, and even globally.

Write about an experience that shows your engagement (through volunteerism, service, or research) with members of your community in an effort to address some issue important to that community.

Resilience and Adaptability

Higher education, like most aspects of life today, can be stressful and constantly changing; experiments fail, deadlines are missed, and papers are rejected. Resilience and adaptability allow you not only to tolerate stressful environments but also to persist and succeed despite them. The resilient person can recover from a set-back and is able to navigate challenges and handle multiple, often competing demands.

Write about an experience that illustrates your capacity for resilience and adaptability.

Accountability and Responsibility

Graduate study requires you to be responsible —to consistently meet your obligations and complete assigned tasks in a timely and satisfactory manner; it also requires you to be accountable to a project, class goal, the success of the lab, research group, or program, and ultimately to your own learning. Students who are both responsible and accountable, own their actions and performance and know their impact on the success of others; they do not blame others for their own mistakes.

Self-Motivation

Self-motivation is the ability to take the initiative to set individual goals and to work independently to make progress toward those goals; a self-motivated person does not wait for others to ask questions or assign tasks.

Write about an experience that shows your ability to set goals and work independently, to own your learning.

Capacity for Self-Improvement

Successful graduate students solicit and respond appropriately to feedback from mentors, instructors, and peers; they are curious, seek opportunities to learn new things, and engage in reflective practice for improvement. They make an effort to honestly recognize their own strengths and weaknesses and to enhance their strengths and mitigate their weaknesses.
