St. Matthews & Indian Hills: Developed in the 1950s-1960s, St. Matthews appeals to young families and professionals looking for less hustle than downtown but more bustle than the east end. An area known for its smaller communities, cute Cape Cod houses and abundance of locally owned restaurants, shopping, grocery and specialty food stores and bars. St. Matthews is also known for its busy commercial streets such as Breckinridge Lane, Shelbyville Road and Westport Road. St. Matthews is home to shopping meccas such as Mall St. Matthews, Oxmoor Center, Westport Village and the Vogue Center. It is also conveniently located to many hospitals, Browns Park, Seneca Park and Big Rock Park. Indian Hills, Mockingbird Valley, Rolling Fields and Windy Hills share St. Matthews's zip code. These prosperous suburbs include some of the most expensive real estate in Louisville. (40207)

East End: Head east down Shelbyville Road, and you will find the middle-class and upper-middle class suburbs of Middletown, Lyndon and Jeffersontown. Middletown's quaint downtown offers an adorable shopping and restaurant district. "J-town" (as locals call it) is the metro's third largest municipality outside of Louisville. The Bluegrass Industrial Park attracts approximately 850 businesses and 38,000 employees. Anchorage is one of the more desirable neighborhoods in Louisville. Home to some of the area's wealthiest citizens, with its spacious homes and 100-year-old trees, Anchorage displays a rural, Southern charm. Much of the city is listed on the National Register of Historic Places. Its beautiful town square feels more down-home than downtown. Anchorage also has its own public elementary and middle school for residents. (40222, 40223, 40242, 40243, 40299)

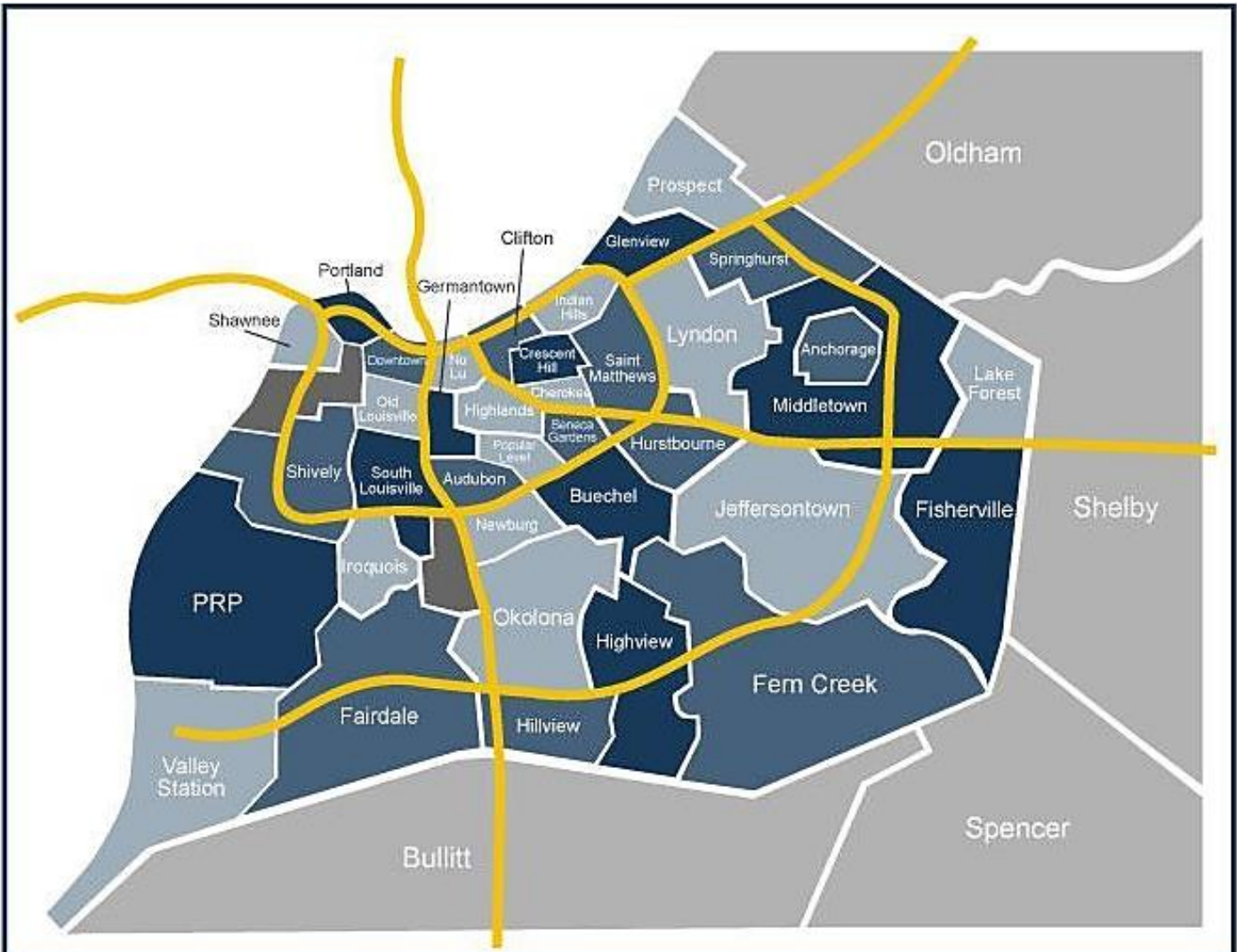
Strathmoor & Gardiner Lane: Characterized by tree-lined streets, spacious houses and its proximities to public parks the mostly residential neighborhoods of Strathmoor/Gardiner Lane/Hawthorne-Wellington and Hayfield-Dundee add charm and beauty to the larger Highlands area. Fun fact: most of the residential streets in Hawthorne are named after writers or poets. Sullivan University is also located in the neighborhood. These residential neighborhoods are quiet but have amenities, such as grocery stores, restaurants, dry cleaners and salons within walking distance. It's also home to the Original Homemade Pie and Ice Cream Kitchen, Morris' Deli and The Bakery at Sullivan. The famed Bambi Walk bar crawl begins at the Bambi Bar in the Strathmoor neighborhood and travels west down Bardstown Rd. and Baxter Ave. (40205, 40218)

Buechel & Hikes Point: The Buechel and Hikes Point neighborhoods consist of medium-sized to small single-family homes and apartments. Nearby Klondike, Bon Air, Avondale-Melbourne Heights and Bashford Manor are ethnically diverse (for the largest selection of Kosher foods in town, head to the Hikes Point Kroger grocery store), middle to lower-income areas. However, recent development, such as Costco coming to Bashford Manor and other big-box retailers should help the areas' revitalization efforts. (40218, 40220)

Beechmont & Iroquois: If authentic ethnic food whets your palate head down the Southside's Southern Parkway. There you will find the ethnically diverse and international neighborhoods of Iroquois and Beechmont. Discover delicious authentic Vietnamese, Cuban, Mexican and Mediterranean cuisine or venture to the many specialty grocery stores featuring goods from Liberia, Kenya, Ethiopia and Bosnia. Visit the Frederick Law Olmsted-designed Iroquois Park. It features scenic viewpoints, a golf course and the Iroquois amphitheater, one of the best concert venues in the city. The Iroquois Branch of the Louisville Free Public Library hosts English conversation clubs and is a gathering spot for Louisville's international community. Other nearby Southside neighborhoods includes Kenwood Hill (whose most famous residents Patty and Mildred J. Hill composed "Happy Birthday to You."), Cloverleaf, Hazelwood, Southside, Southland Parkland and Auburndale. (40214, 40215)

Audobon & Camp Taylor: If the beauty of budding Dogwood Trees and blossoming flowers delights you, head to the quaint Southeast Audubon neighborhood, which hosts the annual Audubon Park Festival of the Dogwood. Nearby Camp Taylor is a former military base that F. Scott Fitzgerald was stationed at and even mentions in his novel "The Great Gatsby." The neighborhood consists of bungalow and Cape Cod homes. The Poplar Level neighborhood is home to Joe Creason Park, the Beargrass Creek State Nature Preserve, The Louisville Nature Center and the Louisville Zoo. (40213, 40217)

Smoketown & Shelby Park: Smoketown and Shelby Park are contiguous neighborhoods immediately southeast of Louisville's central business district. While the brick-making days of Smoketown are long gone, bricks are literally being taken down and rebuilt, as the neighborhood welcomes new, mixed-income housing and demolishes the old, deteriorating Sheppard Square housing project. Nearby, Shelby Park is also benefiting from similar revitalization efforts. Neighborhood architecture features ornate brick and frame homes. The centerpiece of the neighborhood is the Frederick Law Olmsted-designed Shelby Park a 16-acre park with many walking paths, ball fields and picnic areas. Other anchor assets The Park, a co-working space on Shelby Street; St. Vincent de Paul; and Argo and Sons Coffee Roasters. (40203, 40204)
