Once a day as part of a complete regimen

Epzicom is a prescription pill that contains 2 medications in one tablet and is approved by the FDA for the treatment of HIV infection in adults and children over 12 years of age as part of a complete regimen.

Epzicom must be taken in combination with other HIV medications.

How should I take Epzicom?

- Take Epzicom **with your other HIV medications** at the **same time everyday**.
- Epzicom can be taken with or without food.

What drugs interact with Epzicom?

- Epzicom is safe to be taken with most medications.
- If you are unsure if a medicine is safe to take with your Epzicom, call the clinic pharmacist to double check.

What should I do if I forget a dose?

- If you miss a dose, take the missed dose as soon as you remember!
- If it is within 4 hours of your next dose, skip the missed dose and take the next dose at your regular time.
- Do NOT take two doses at the same time.

Side Effects

The most common side effects of Epzicom are nausea and headache.

Most side effects go away within a few days of starting your medicine

Contact the clinic if any of these side effects become severe or prevent you from taking your medicine.

Contact the clinic or go to the emergency department if you experience any of the following:

- Rash
- Symptoms of an allergic reaction
