

Refilling Medications

You should <u>never</u> run out of your medications!

- Contact your pharmacy when you have 5-10 days left of medications
- If there are no refills left on your prescription, your pharmacy will contact the 550 clinic to renew your prescription → you do not have to call the 550 clinic
- The 550 clinic will send your prescription electronically to your pharmacy
- Depending on your specific pharmacy, your medications will either be mailed to you or will need to be picked up from the store
