- The applicant/recipient must be a full-time sworn law enforcement officer employed by a state, county, or municipal law enforcement agency in one of the following states: Connecticut, Massachusetts, Maine, New Hampshire, Rhode Island or Vermont.
- 3. The applicant/recipient must be a first-line supervisor or above within his/her organizational structure (an individual holding command, supervisory, or administrative positions in his/her agency).
- 4. The application must be from the applicant and endorsed under separate cover, on departmental letterhead, by the chief administrator of the applicant's organization demonstrating fiscal need for the scholarship funds and/or the benefit of the training program for the agency and applicant.
- 5. The applicant must submit a current photograph in JPEG format and agree to have the photo and scholarship award announcement published by SPI.
