- Construction on new residence hall to replace Threlkeld to begin in January
- Floyd garage Pedestrian walkway Update Access to and from the Belknap Campus will need to be through the SAC 3rd floor railroad overpass or University Blvd.
 - As of this morning the goal is to have all work complete by Dec. 30th
 - Work has resumed and they are moving at a steady pace. Old concrete platforms have been removed and new concrete platforms are installed. Currently they are working to install the protective barrier back in place.
 - Access to and from the Belknap Campus will remain through the SAC 3rd floor railroad overpass or University Blvd through December 18th. SAC will be closed from December 19-January 3 for the University Holiday Break.

- Updated everyone on construction fencing plan for residence hall to replace Threlkeld. Construction fence plans concerns led to a meeting with key campus constituents (Housing, SAC, DRC, Shumaker, Fire Marshall, Parking, Physical Plant, Grounds, UPDC) UofL Dining plans to be completed with the expansion/renovation and ready to be fully open at the start of the Spring semester. All potential concerns on the construction site footprint were voiced. Messer Construction and UPDC worked to resolve all potential pedestrian and vehicle access needs to the best possible solution.
- S&F will have a spot on a campus signage committee.
- Updated everyone on the progress of the Pedestrian Walkway.
- Discussed a concern from Dennis Thomas on security on HSC campus due to increased homeless population. Those concerns match with plans from ULPD to address safety concerns on HSC.
- Encouraged everyone to keep eyes out as we all return to campus for things that S&F need to try to address for repair or improvement.
