

## DINING ADVISORY COMMITTEE REPORT

### Spring 2021

- 65 Events held Spring 2021 semester
- Other Initiatives: chef highlights, supervisors/employee highlights
- Remained committed to culinary services
- Food Truck Fest
  - February 2021 - 1500 guests in 3 days
  - April 2021 – 1,000 guests
- Home Chef Kits
  - Meal kit service that will ship everything needed to cook a meal
  - Purchase through UofL Dining Grubhub app
  - 200 kits sold Spring 2021 semester
- Pod to Pantry
  - Students can use unused flex points to purchase and donate select items from dining service's pod to the Cardinal Cupboard
  - Pod to Pantry will be available next year (Fall 2021, Spring 2022)
- Voice of Consumer Platform
  - Allows feedback from consumers
  - Over 1900 responses received, 91% overall satisfaction rate
- Ville Grille Renovations
  - Renovations were completed in January and the new space opened
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> floor, 200 seats, programming area (looking to host trivia nights in the fall)
- Health Department Scores
  - Health inspection occurs every 6 months
  - 10 locations – 100%
  - 4 locations – 99%
  - 1 location – 98%
