### EV Charging Station Infrastructure

- Physical Plant is opposed to have electric vehicles charging on standard AC outlets. Physical Plant does not have adequate staffing to monitor to make sure these are not negatively impacting electric on campus or outlets have tripped.
- Parking & Transportation Services will create standard electric vehicle charging procedures and post on website. Will allow 4 hour charging maximum and will “chalk” vehicles parking in space. Will issue a “warning” citation initially to remind users of charging times.
- University Advancement investigating with current partners to see if opportunities are available to donate new electric vehicle charging stations to University.

### Construction

- Thrust Theater and SPI reserve parking lots were milled and paved during summer period
- Floyd Street Garage- maintenance work is currently underway. Maintenance includes painting, expansion joint replacements, traffic coats, striping, barrier cable replacement, new drains, concrete repairs
- Floyd Street South- parking lot lost due to construction of Denny Crum residence hall

### 2020-21

- No permit increases
- New construction project at 4<sup>th</sup> & Brandeis is scheduled to begin February, 2022. Construction will cause closure of employee parking lot at 3<sup>rd</sup> & Brandeis Ave. Employee parking will be moved to current resident spaces at end of Cardinal Blvd next to Kurz Hall.
