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INFORMATION ITEM: Master of Arts in Higher Education Administration (MAHEA) Hohmann

- University employees may be eligible to complete the program with UofL's tuition remission benefit
- Most students already work in higher education or are interested in making a career change
- Graduates from the program:
 - Gain an understanding of the history, philosophy, and legal foundations of American higher education
 - Understand and can apply administrative skills such as leadership, HR management, finance and budgeting
 - Know the responsibilities and roles of college and university faculty
 - Understand issues of cultural and institutional diversity within college and university settings
- Students must select one of four different concentrations: Administration, Teaching & Learning, Policy & Equity, or Sports Administration
- All courses are offered 100% online
- Students can graduate in 2 years if enrolled full-time and within 2.5-3 years if enrolled part-time
