

FACULTY SENATE REPORT TO STAFF SENATE 11/2021

The University of Louisville Faculty Senate met on November 3, 2021. The meeting was called to order by chairman David Schultz at 3:00 PM.

There were not items requiring a faculty senate vote. There were these two reports that merited some special attention:

SGA Representative Alexa Meza reported there are some concerns that students have with campus security, especially on the recent assaults on campus. Some students feel their concerns aren't being heard by campus security, that ULPD and Chief Lewis aren't being receptive. The SGA has a goal to put out a statement on social media about not hearing student concerns.

Faculty Senate Chair David Schultz stated that he would like senators to approach collaboration with administrators in a little more positive light. There are some pockets of faculty members who are still holding on to past hurts and still approach the administration in a confrontational manner. He requested we try to be proactive and suggest solutions.

There were other standing committee reports but no other discussion items.
