Virginia spoke with Donna Bartman and was informed that it is not possible to have a mechanism to select "opt-in" for Shared Leave within the open enrollment portal. Virginia plans to follow-up with her again to keep the policy moving.

In preparation for our meeting with HR we plan to move forward with the following suggestions to the TML (Temporary Medical Leave) Policy:

- o TML should mirror the FML (Family Medical Leave) policy
- Allow intermittent and continuous TML as long as it relates to a previous FML event
- o Remove the 12 weeks over a lifetime limitation, but instead allow it to renew over a 36-month period.

Action Request:

Performance Evaluation policy will be reviewed.
