- 1. When school is in sessions, the TARC shelter in front of CEHD on Cardinal Blvd seems to be a massive scooter dump site. They seem to be Lime, Bird and Bolt. Sometimes up to 10 or more at a time.
  - a. Shawn Blackston sent an email to all of the scooter companies reminding them to be mindful of staging scooter near campus, blocking sidewalks. He also walked over to visually inspect for scooters. - 2. Concern about Unity Place blind spots for pedestrians. Could there be either speed humps, better signage and/or a crosswalk especially for the alley that cuts up towards the SRC?
  - a. Mike Materna with UPDC met with Glenn Gittings on Jan. 29th at Unity Place to discuss measures of safety. We reviewed the site and came up with suggested safety improvements, which Mike will connect, with our city road planners and the state to see if we can accelerate provisions for safety.
