- Scooters, Phillip Carswell & Dennis Thomas reviewing. To review Louisville Metro Ordinance Chapter 74 regulating dockless vehicles and how any parts can be incorporated for our use on campus scooters. For Scooters that are parked too close to building entrances and exits, as well as blocking walkways. In process.
- Update – On the report came in of a University of Louisville I-65 South expressway sign being blocked by trees. Building Systems Engineer Donnie Thomas has been in contact with John Hill Ky Transportation District 5 regrading tree trimming. In process.
- I-65 South Jefferson/Brook Street exit ramp conditions, Update: The Kentucky Transportation Cabinet (KYTC) and Louisville Metro are partnering with the Federal Highways Administration (FHWA) to reconfigure these ramps and corresponding intersections. A public information session was held on Thursday, October 28, 2021 at 7 p.m. to discuss this project.
