Committee Business

An official reading of the Committee's proposed name change was made at the April full Senate meeting. The change was confirmed in the April Executive Committee meeting.

Melissa later met with Human Resources and confirmed this type of scheduling is allowed, but must meet the needs of the department and approval is up to the individual supervisors.
