#### **UPDATE: University Police - Chief Steve Green**

Chief Green reported that crime on campus mainly involves car and bicycle thefts, and less violent crimes. The increased surveillance and additional security guards in some lots has helped. In January, ULPD will test camera poles near the Student Recreation Center to see if that technology is worth buying. Chief Green then explained about the RAVE alert that went out and caused much confusion on Belknap Campus last month. Clarifying changes have been made to the wording of the alert in this type of situation. Chief Green apologized and took responsibility for the poor communication.

Ms. Meagan West, from the Employee Success Center updated senators on current activities. Applications for the *Mentoring for Success* program are open until December 31<sup>st</sup>.
