**REPORT**: University Provost - In addition to recordbreaking enrollment for Fall 2024, UofL has seen recordbreaking to Fall 2024. retention (81%) from Fall 2023

There are currently 5 Dean and VP searches in various phases: 1) Dean, College of Business; 2) Dean, School of Dentistry; 3) Executive VP of Finance and Administration (CFO); 4) Executive VP of Research and Innovation (EVPRI); and 5) Executive VP of Philanthropy and Alumni Affairs.

INTRODUCTION: Dean of the School of Nursing - Dean Nash is delighted to return to UofL.

**FEEDBACK:** Centers & Institutes (Goldstein) - There has been a lack of oversight in the creation of centers and institutes, which technically need Board approval (after committee approval), so a new process has been put into place.

**INFORMATION ITEM:** University Libraries (Fox) - new budget model doesn't accommodate academic units that don't have tuitionpaying students, plus it requires costs to be carried by units that once were handled centrally (COLAs, faculty promotions). This, plus inflation, created a \$750K deficit, requiring Libraries to cut subscriptions; had to focus on those up for renewal this FY, which disproportionately affected social sciences. Provost restored \$400K to Libraries and they are looking into which highest-use titles can be restored individually with that. Will face this every year, unless budget model changes. Dean Fox encouraged faculty to fill out the feedback form.
