Nick Bowes and Laura Clemente from the Athletic Department discussed their data-driven approach to ticket pricing, focusing on factors such as demand, market research, and premium games. They explained the use of external market research firms like Elevate and Legends to analyze ticket pricing and opportunities, which helps them understand the current standing and make informed decisions. Also discussed was the impact of premium games on ticket demand and pricing, using examples like Kentucky and Clemson games, which significantly affect season ticket sales and pricing strategies.

INFORMATION: Retirement Plan Changes - Greg Paradiso

Mr. Greg Paradiso, the Retirement Lead in Human Resources presented changes to the retirement plan investment options, emphasizing the streamlined menu and the introduction of a brokerage window for more investment choices. He introduced the changes to the retirement plan investment options, focusing on modernizing the fund options and improving the participant experience.

INFORMATION: TARC and Cardinal Card - Gary Becker

Mr. Gary Becker announced that starting April 1, employees and students will need to use a virtual pass instead of their UofL ID to access TARC services. This change aims to ensure that only current employees and enrolled students use the service. He explained that users will need to download the Transit Token app and receive a monthly virtual pass via email. The pass will be a QR code scanned from a smartphone when boarding TARC buses.
