Schatzel

- Attended the State of the City, State of the Commonwealth, and State of the Union address (as a guest of Rep. Morgan McGarvey)
- Judge ruled that NIH funding cuts cannot take place, but there are still unknowns since there has been a pause on grant processing
- Has been explaining to legislators what indirect costs are and why those funds are so important
- Directed FS Chair to share <u>FAQs</u> that followed up on the <u>Dear Colleague letter</u>
- <u>KY HB4</u>, which has now passed the House, targets non-academic training for employees. There are extensive carveouts from the 2024 version of the bill. It should not impact research, classes, accreditation, etc.
- Acknowledged the fear and anxiety this situation has created around our ability to educate our students. The level of uncertainty is also challenging.
- We are not stopping doctoral applications and faculty should continue with their research as best as possible.
- We do not discriminate.
- Proposed Medicaid cuts would have an enormous impact, particularly on rural hospitals in KY (which has the 2nd highest usage of Medicaid in the country)

Report: University Provost

DePuy

- College of Business Dean candidates will visit campus soon
- Fall 2025 deposits are up by 380+ when compared to Fall 2023 (2024 not used due to FAFSA issues)
- "15 to Finish" campaign encouraging students to take 15 credit hours/semester
 - This helps students maintain full-time status, graduate on time, reduces debt, and helps
 UofL to obtain performance funding
 - Data shows hours attempted are up, hours completed are a bit down, and students' GPAs are up
- Life Sciences and Humanities will close for renovations in Spring 2026, but all classes have already been relocated
- Inclement Weather Policy: Working with HR on a plan that addresses university closures versus remote work/instruction

Waddle

- Adding more funds to cover testing center fees
- Extending library hours during finals
- Traveled to DC to advocate for various issues including federal consensus on NIL funding (so schools with different state laws won't have a leg up on recruiting)

- Additions to the talk since presenting to Staff Senate:
 - Students only need to download a QR code once per semester; Parking "can look at adjusting frequency" for employees
 - Not everyone received the email with the QR code; working with OCM to get correct email list for all current students/employees
 - People without smartphones have to get one but he can provide resources for free/cheap ones
 - New process doesn't take effect until 4/1 but everyone is encouraged to test it now so they can work out the kinks
 - Very strong hints that this benefit will not remain free
